FINDS IT, WHEREEVER IT IS ON THE INTERNET: DEVONAGENT 1.0

Bietigheim-Bissingen (Germany, EU), 15th of October, 2003 -- DEVONagent, DEVONtechnologies' intelligent search agent and alternative browser, is now final. DEVONagent 1.0 is immediately available for everyone as a free download from www.devon-technologies.com and can be used for 60 hours runtime until it must be registered for US\$ 35. Also, DEVONtechnologies offers both its key applications, DEVONthink PE and DEVONagent as a bundle for attractive US\$ 60.

The final version of DEVONagent comes with new Mac OS X services for starting queries and open a selected URL in the internal Safari-powered web browser, dock menu commands directly open new browser, query or crawler windows and it's now possible to drag multiple results to DEVONthink, DEVONtechnologies' knowledge database. Also, the »Apple Developer Connection« plug-in and the »Webcam« scanner have been improved, the crawler sets revised, some minor localisation and interfaces glitches removed and the overall performance enhanced.

Both applications, DEVONthink and DEVONagent have been designed to work together for those who want to have a knowledge database with powerful Internet searching capabilities or a search agent with high-end archive. The new DEVONthink+DEVONagent Bundle makes it easier for customers with these needs to buy both applications for an attractive price.

DEVONagent 1.0 runs on any Mac with Mac OS X 10.2, 256 MB RAM and Safari installed. A fast Internet connection is recommended. DEVONagent 1.0 is available as a free download from www.devon-technologies.com and must be registered after a trial period of 60 runtime hours for US\$ 35. The DEVONthink+DEVONagent Bundle is also immediately available for US\$ 60 in the DEVONtechnologies Online Shop.

DEVONAGENT BACKGROUND

Based on DEVONtechnologies' revolutionary DEVONtechnology, DEVONagent is the information finding tool of the next generation. It simulates the behaviour of a human web surfer scanning the Internet for a specific piece of information. Technically, DEVONagent uses a variety of searching techniques and collects the results from major search engines. Then it visits all the found web sites, downloads, analyses and weights them to find the most relevant pages, eliminating information junk (empty pages, HTTP errors, sites that don't contain the search phrase, similar or duplicate pages, or pages with too little information) automatically on-the-fly.

Especially useful for anyone visiting the same pages over and over again to see if there's something published about a specific topic are crawlers. They scans through lists of interesting pages and reports only those dealing with what the user is looking for. Also, so-called scanner post-process the result list and filter out all pages that don't match certain formal criteria such as »Contains a webcam« or »Features web galleries«.

The final results are presented by DEVONagent in a plain list, sorted by decreasing relevance, together with a first summary of all paragraphs that DEVONagent thinks are the most relevant to the query. A double-click on any link opens the pages directly in an integrated web browser built upon the fast and rock-solid Safari engine (including Java, JavaScript, Plug-Ins and all the rest).

A second, more spectacular view shows a list with the most important topics related to the query and a digest instantly created for selected topics or based on the query. Occurrences of the selected topics words are highlighted, the digest is editable and can be saved as plain text or RTF. Both views, page list and digest, are easily accessible through tabs below the toolbar. Also, selected pages can be exported as HTML, plain text or RTF/RTFD. In almost all cases, the results filtered and weighted by DEVONagent are much better than those returned by the standard search engines. Additionally, DEVONagent stores all or selected results in a searchable archive very similar to DEVONthink, DEVONtechnologies' current flagship freeform database and knowledge manager (commands to store selected pages or links to them in DEVONagent are also available).
