## DESKTOP TRANSPORTER 2.0: "BEAM ME OVER TO THAT OTHER MAC, SCOTTY"

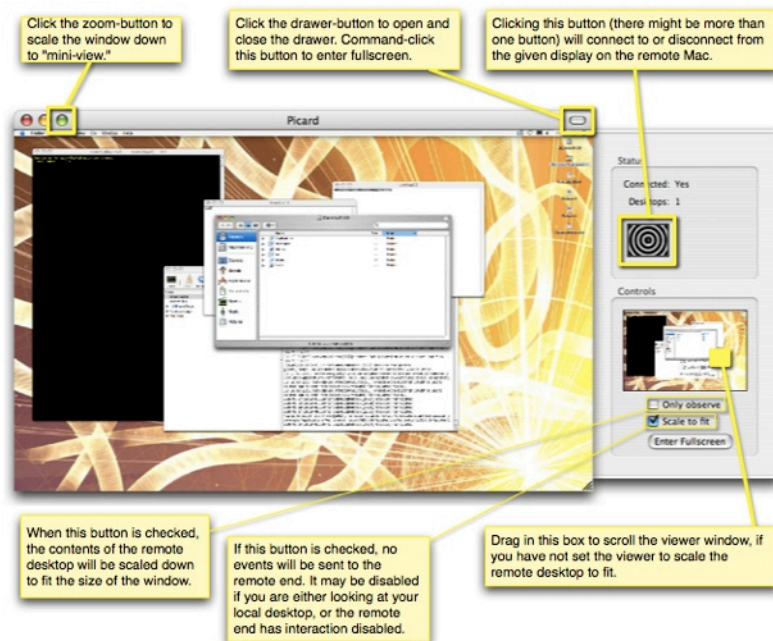
Coeur d'Alene (Idaho, USA), 9th of November, 2006 – DEVONtechnologies, LLC takes over distribution of the remote desktop solution Desktop Transporter and presents the completely overhauled version 2.0.

Desktop Transporter is a remote desktop solution that allows users to use other Macs on either the local network or the Internet without physically accessing them. Like the much more expensive Apple Remote Desktop, Desktop Transporter shows the screen of the remote Mac either in a window or in full screen and allows the user to interact with the other computer as if it was the local one.

Version 2.0, which is, of course, available as a Universal Binary for both Intel and PowerPC based Macs, is a major update to the previously available version 1.4. A new

menu extra makes it possible to access remote Macs without launching the main Desktop Transporter application, while a background helper application takes care of sharing desktops even when the menu extra and main application are not running.

Using Bonjour, the presence of a shared Mac on the local network is made known, making it unnecessary to pass IP addresses around. In addition, Desktop Trans-

porter 'survives' Fast User Switching. A shared desktop remains shared even if the user switches to another user account. This can, for example, be used to use multiple accounts on the same machine without actually switching back and forth between them.

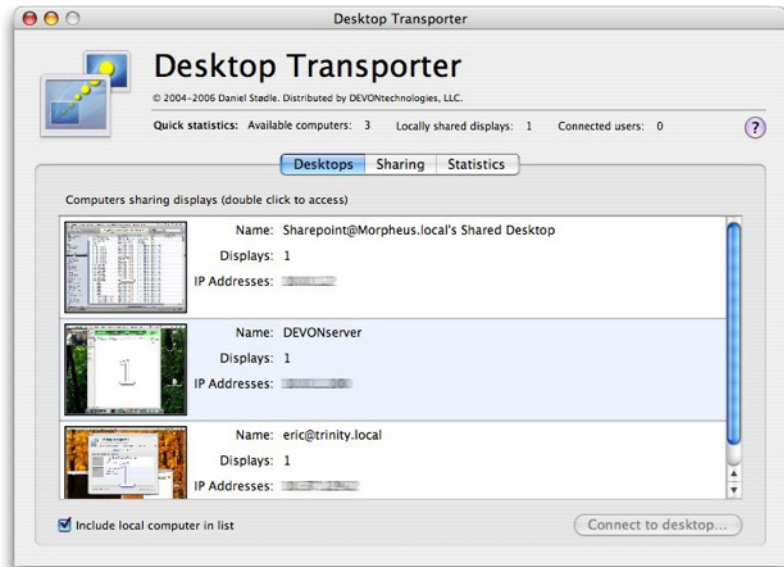
Other features of Desktop Transporter include: Clipboard synchronization for text and graphics in both

directions, hardware acceleration, and support for non-English keyboards. The latter is one of the main drawbacks of free solutions such as VNC when used outside English-speaking countries.

Desktop Transporter was developed by Norwegian Mac developer Daniel Stødle. Mr Stødle and DEVONtechnologies, LLC have signed an agreement to distribute Desktop Transporter from now on as part of DEVONtechnologies' software portfolio. The application has been re-branded and is available now from DEVONtechnologies' website. All rights on Desktop Transporter remain with Daniel Stødle.

"We are proud to announce this new partnership with Mr. Stødle. It's a perfect addition to our product portfolio," says Eric Böhnisch-Volkman, President of DEVONtechnologies, LLC. "Desktop Transporter is a powerful remote desktop solution with advanced features that we can offer for a more than reasonable price. If one works with multiple Macs, at home or in the office, or if one has to manage a server somewhere else on the planet, it's such a smart solution with a an easy to use interface and pro-grade feature set." Daniel Stødle, the developer of Desktop Transporter, agrees: "Usability, comfort, and powerful features were what I had in mind when I created Desktop Transporter. I am totally convinced that this agreement with DEVONtechnologies will make it available to a much broader community."

Desktop Transporter 2.0 requires Mac OS X 10.3.9 later and a fast LAN connection is strongly recommended. It is immediately available as a free download from
